

SHOWMEN'S LEAGUE OF AMERICA STL
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
GUIDELINES

New Applicants Undergraduate (graduating from high school):

1. Complete the application form. Mail in with one page typed essay on how the outdoor amusement industry has affected your life, a colored picture of yourself that may be used in our publications and an official sealed copy of your high school transcripts. Must be postmarked no later than March 1st. If all items have not been received by due date your request for consideration will be denied.
2. You must be sponsored by a family member who is a member of the Showmen's League of America STL or a member. You will be expected to join the Showmen's League of America STL when you reach the age of 18.
3. An official sealed copy of your high school transcript must be mailed once you are awarded a scholarship two times a year. They must be received by March 1st and June 15th annually. If these are not received you may lose your scholarship.
4. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 minimum.
5. Approved for four years for college/university if you continue to meet criteria. Approved for two years for community college if you continue to meet criteria. (You may reapply for additional two years if you transfer to college/university).

New Applicants Undergraduate (already in college/university):

1. Complete the application form. Mail in with one page typed essay on how the outdoor amusement industry has affected your life, a colored picture of yourself that may be used in our publications and an official sealed copy of your college/university transcripts. Must be postmarked no later than March 1st. If all items have not been received by due date your request for consideration will be denied.
2. You must be a member of the Showmen's League of America STL.
3. If you are awarded scholarship and you are (example) a sophomore you will be awarded scholarship for two years only if you continue to meet the criteria. This goes for if you are a junior and are awarded you will be eligible for a one year scholarship.
4. An official sealed copy of your college/university transcript must be mailed once you are awarded a scholarship two times a year. They must be received by March 1st and June 15th annually. If these are not received you may lose your scholarship.
5. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 minimum.

New Applicants Master's Program:

1. Complete the application form. Mail in with an in depth typed essay on how the outdoor amusement industry has affected your life, a colored picture of yourself that may be used in our publications and an official sealed copy of your college/university transcripts. Must be postmarked no later than March 1st. If all items have not been received by due date your request for consideration will be denied.
2. All Guidelines listed on application must be completed.
3. Must be entering Graduate school within 24 months of graduation.
4. In order to receive second year scholarship you must have Advisor/Counselor submit a recommendation. This must be received by June 15th.
5. Must be a member of the Showmen's League of America STL.

NOTICE TO ALL APPLICANTS:

If you miss a deadlines you may cause risk to losing your scholarship. If you do not send in all criteria required by due date your request for consideration will be denied. This scholarship is paid directly to the school from the Showmen's League of America STL and may only be used towards the following: tuition, books and lab fees. If any amount goes unused it shall be refunded to the Showmen's League of America STL. If you change college/university it is your responsibility to notify the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee by mail or email. It will also be your responsibility to ensure that any amount due from college/university is sent to the Treasurer or Chairman of the Scholarship committee payable to The Showmen's League of America STL.
